

## Visiting Assistant Professor in Analytics

The School of Management at Bucknell University seeks a full-time visiting faculty member qualified to teach undergraduate courses in business analytics and quantitative modeling. The appointment will start in August 2016 and last for one academic year (2016-2017).

The School, an AACSB-accredited unit, offers innovative professional education in the context of one of the nation's leading liberal arts universities. We believe that an education that combines technical skills and deep intellectual exploration is the best preparation for thoughtful and capable leaders. Thus, we seek faculty members capable of contributing to this mission. We also embrace the teacher-scholar model. Although visiting faculty are not required to engage in research, we look with particular favor on those who are making creative intellectual contributions to both teaching and scholarship in their fields. The teaching load for visiting faculty members is six classes per year. The School is also committed to diversity, inclusion, and student-centered pedagogy.

A record of excellence in undergraduate teaching is required. Qualified candidates will have completed or be near completion of the Ph.D. degree or equivalent. Salary is competitive and commensurate with experience.
