The successful candidate must have a record of strong teaching experience and evidence of scholarly work. Professional experience desirable but not required. Candidates with completed doctorate (PhD/DBA) in a relevant discipline are preferred, active ABDs will be considered.

Depending on qualifications, teaching load will be 9 credit hours a semester at either the graduate or undergraduate levels. Classes may be scheduled on-campus in Garden City or at off-campus sites, in the day or evening, and on Saturdays.
