

## **Non-Tenure Clinical Track Position in Supply Chain Management The Pennsylvania State University – Department of Supply Chain and Information Systems**

The Department of Supply Chain and Information Systems at the Smeal College of Business invites qualified applications for a non-tenure track faculty position in the area of Supply Chain Management. The position would begin in Fall 2018 at the clinical assistant professor level. Salary is competitive.

Candidates must have a doctorate degree (granted or near completion) in supply chain management or related field and a strong commitment to teaching excellence at the undergraduate and master's degree levels. Particularly desirable are candidates with a record of high-quality instruction in a student-centered environment, an enthusiasm for collaborative learning environments, and an interest in educational technologies and online pedagogy.
