Assistant or Associate Professor of Management- School of Business

Description

The School of Business at The College of New Jersey invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant or Associate Professor of Management beginning academic year 2019-2020. An earned doctorate in an appropriate discipline from an AACSB accredited business school is required for appointment. A Ph.D. in Management is preferred. ABD candidates may be considered only on the condition of full doctoral completion by August 2019.

The successful candidate will demonstrate (1) the ability to provide instructional excellence in courses in areas of specialization; (2) a planned scholarly agenda consistent with expectations of an AACSB-accredited program; and (3) a commitment to undergraduate education and active participation in the development of innovative and/or interdisciplinary courses.

Primary teaching responsibility will be in Operations Management/Supply Chain Management, with high expectations of leading engaged classrooms. Therefore, along with an active research agenda, evidence of effective teaching is especially important. Strength in quantitative data analysis and decision making is especially valued. The Management department supports an undergraduate management concentration and minors in management and human resource management.
