

Job Description: Visiting Assistant Professor in Business Analytics

The Department of Management and Marketing, Richard T. Doermer School of Business at Indiana University-Purdue University Fort Wayne (IPFW) invites applications for a Visiting Assistant Professor to teach undergraduate and MBA courses in business analytics and cross functional capabilities in any of the following areas: Healthcare Analytics, Supply Chain Analytics, Information Analytics, Digital, Consumer & Retail Analytics as well as Finance & Insurance Analytics. Ability to teach courses such as Predictive Analytics, Risk Analytics, Revenue Management, and Pricing Analytics in the MBA program is desirable. The successful candidate is expected to conduct research in business analytics and contribute to the activities of Center of Excellence in Business Analytics with research, scholarship and professional/academic engagement. Visiting position to begin August 15, 2016. Candidates should possess Ph.D. in Management Science, Operations Research, Industrial Engineering, Systems Engineering, or Engineering Management. ABDs in advanced stages will be considered. Candidates with industrial experience and/or 2-3 years of teaching experience in university settings are preferred. The successful candidate should demonstrate ability to contribute to our AACSB-accredited business programs.
