Our ideal candidate will have a research agenda that focuses on the use of business analytics and analytical models to address business problems in one or more of the following areas: Supply Chain & Logistics, Service Operations, Health Care Operations, Transportation or Corporate Sustainability. We also look for technically competent candidates who have evidence of teaching effectiveness with an interest in teaching in our undergraduate Business Analytics major as well as other operations and supply chain courses.
