Our ideal candidate will have a research agenda that focuses on the use of business analytics and analytical models to address business and societal problems in one or more of the following areas: Supply Chain & Logistics, Service Operations, Health Care Operations, Transportation or Corporate Sustainability. We also look for technically competent candidates who have evidence of teaching effectiveness with an interest in teaching in our undergraduate Business Analytics major as well as other operations and supply chain courses.

About the University: NBS is AACSB- and EQUIS-accredited and is currently ranked No. 29 in the 2016 Financial Times MBA ranking, putting it the highest ranked MBA program in Singapore and No. 6 in Asia Pacific. Young and research-intensive, NTU is ranked 13th globally. It is also placed 1st amongst the world's best young universities.

About the Department: The OM faculty at Nanyang Business School is part of the Information Technology & Operations Management (ITOM) Division which, apart from the undergraduate major in Business Analytics, offers courses in Technology Strategy & Management, Innovation, Corporate Sustainability, Operations, and Supply Chain Management in the UG, Masters, MBA, EMBA and PhD Programs.
