



Tenure-Track Faculty Positions in Operations and Supply Chain Management

The **Olin Business School at Washington University in St. Louis** is seeking qualified candidates for tenure-track faculty positions at assistant or untenured associate level in **Operations and Manufacturing Management**, with effective hire date of July 1, 2018. Positions are subject to approval. The job candidate requirements are: doctoral degree (or near completion in the case of the Assistant rank) and strong records (or exceptional promise in both teaching and research based on early professional accomplishments for the case of Associate rank).

The selected candidates will be expected to teach courses in Analytics, Operations and Supply Chain Management (and related areas) effectively in the bachelor's, master's, and/or Ph.D. programs; conduct research, publish in peer-reviewed journals, advise/mentor students and participate in promoting the intellectual environment at the school.

Olin Business School encourages women, minorities, dual career couples, and persons with disabilities to apply. Candidates from both within the USA and from outside the USA borders will be given full consideration.

Olin Business School has 93 full-time faculty and offers degree programs at the bachelor's, master's and PhD Level. The School has excellent general support for both research and teaching. The business school has excellent facilities with four state-of-the-art buildings. The two newest buildings, Knight Hall and Bauer Hall, opened for use in March 2014. Applications should be received by December 8, 2017 for full consideration, however the search will continue until the positions are filled.

An application is considered complete with the following components: vitae, cover letter of interest, statement of teaching philosophy and approach or research statement summarizing accomplishments, and copies of published or unpublished papers (no more than three).
