



### **Assistant/Associate Professor**

The College of Business at Oregon State University in Corvallis, OR invites applicants for an anticipated full time (1.0 FTE), nine-month, tenure-track position in Operations Management/Supply Chain Management at the rank of Assistant Professor or Associate Professor (Tenured) with a targeted start date of September 2018.

Primary teaching responsibilities include delivering undergraduate and graduate courses in Operations Management/Supply Chain Management. Scholarly activities are expected to result in peer-reviewed top-quality journal publications. Service to the College, University, and profession are also expected.

Salary is competitive and commensurate with education and experience. Employee benefits are excellent. Required qualifications include an appropriate earned doctorate from an AACSB International accredited university (or equivalent) in Operations or Supply Chain Management with an emphasis in Service Operations, Supply Chain Management and Logistics, by employment start date, evidence of strong (associate professorship) or potential (assistant professorship) for empirically-grounded research and scholarly publication and relevant teaching experience at the university level. Preferred qualifications include a demonstrated ability to collaborate in scholarly pursuits with colleagues located locally and remotely; relevant professional non-academic work experience and ability to develop strong linkages with the business community; interest in production/service operations, sustainability, and supply chain management; and a demonstrable commitment to promoting and enhancing diversity.

The College of Business offers undergraduate and MBA degrees (in face-to-face, on-line and hybrid formats) in Corvallis (main campus) and enhanced on-line instruction in Portland, Oregon. The candidate may have the option to teach primarily in Corvallis or Portland.

#### **Minimum Qualification:**

- A Ph.D. in Supply Chain Management, Operations Management, Logistics, Supply Chain Analytics or related fields from an AACSB International accredited university.
- Evidence of strong (associate professorship) or potential (assistant professorship) for empirically-grounded research and scholarly publication and relevant teaching experience at the university level.
- Development of a research program with evidence of or potential for research and scholarly publication in the areas of operations.
- Demonstrated ability to teach in a classroom and/or online setting.

#### **Preferred Qualification:**

- Strong research interests in industry sectors including high-tech manufacturing, e-commerce, food production, healthcare and apparel and sportswear.

- Strong ability to work with industries and experience in working with industry on capstone course projects, supply chain consulting.
- Relevant professional non-academic work experience and ability to develop strong linkages with the business community.
- Interest in production/service operations, sustainability, and supply chain management.
- Demonstrated ability to collaborate in scholarly pursuits with colleagues located locally and remotely.
- Demonstrable commitment to promoting and enhancing diversity.
