

Visiting Lecturer, Supply Chain & Operations Management

The Department of Business and Supply Chain Management at the State University of New York College at Plattsburgh invites applications for a one-year Visiting Lecturer effective Spring 2017, with the possibility of a one-year renewal. The primary expertise will be in Supply Chain Management and Operations Management. The successful candidate will be committed to excellence in teaching and service in an institution dedicated primarily to undergraduate education. He or she will be expected to demonstrate an understanding of and sensitivity to diversity and gender issues, as SUNY Plattsburgh is committed to ensuring that its graduates are educated to succeed in an increasingly complex, multicultural, and interdependent world.

Responsibilities include: The successful candidate will teach undergraduate courses in Supply Chain Management, and may be assigned to teach a course in Global Operations Management, as well as other Supply Chain Management courses in his/her area of interest and expertise. The faculty member shall perform student advisement along with departmental, college, and university level service. Candidates may be asked to teach courses in a distance learning format.

Required Qualifications: The faculty member must be academically or professionally qualified through AACSB standards, either through research or through professional work. Consideration will be given to ABD candidates as well as candidates with an earned Master's degree who have substantial managerial and/or executive level experience in Supply Chain Management or a related field. All applicants must have a commitment to teaching excellence at the undergraduate level. The successful candidate will have demonstrated the ability to work effectively and collegially with faculty, staff, and administrators.

Preferred Qualifications: Ph.D. in Supply Chain Management, Operations Management or related field preferred. Preference will be given to candidates with relevant teaching experience at the university level and to applicants with a sustained interest in scholarly research. Those individuals with experience or an interest in current web-based instructional delivery are encouraged to apply.
