### Position and Qualifications

The Management Department of the Jon M. Huntsman School of Business at Utah State University invites applications for a faculty position in Operations Management at the Assistant, Associate or Full Professor, Assistant, Associate, or Professor of Practice, or Lecturer, Senior Lecturer level to begin in Fall 2019. The minimum qualifications for this position are:

**Assistant, Associate or Full Professor:** This is a tenure track position that requires a Ph.D. in operations/supply chain management, demonstrated excellence in teaching, and an established record of scholarship including at least one publication in an 'A' journal in operations/supply chain management and other evidence of a productive research agenda. The nine-month, tenure-track position will receive ample resources to support the development and maintenance of programs of excellence in both teaching and research.

**Assistant, Associate, or Professor of Practice:** This position requires a Ph.D. and a minimum of 10 years operations experience, preferably including executive level experience. The nine-month, non-tenure track, faculty position will be primarily teaching with some service and research responsibilities.

**Lecturer, Senior Lecturer:** This position requires a Master's degree with 10 years industry experience in operations management, preferably including executive level experience. This will be a nine-month, non-tenure track, teaching and service position.

Faculty in the Huntsman School of Business are also expected to provide leadership in their respective programs and to make meaningful contributions to the academic and professional communities. Salary is competitive and based on the candidate's qualifications and experience. Summer teaching, research grants, and other opportunities for extra service compensation may also be available. An excellent benefits package includes TIAA/CREF retirement programs, life, medical, dental, and disability insurance.
