The Department of Finance and Management Science in the Carson College of Business at Washington State University is seeking candidates for a visiting faculty position with a one-year appointment from August 16, 2017, to May 15, 2018, at the Pullman campus.

Qualifications: Candidates for the visiting professor position must possess a PhD degree in a Management Science related field from a nationally or internationally recognized university by the employment start date. Qualified candidates must demonstrate effectiveness and excellence in teaching. Salary and rank are commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Preferred qualifications: Teaching experience in the area of management and operations is preferred.

Job duties: This position will be responsible for teaching Management Science courses. Normal teaching load is nine hours (3 courses per semester).

University/College/Community: Washington State University conducts transformational research and provides world-class education to more than 26,000 undergraduate, graduate, and professional students. Founded in 1890 in Pullman, it is Washington's original land-grant university. The College of Business is AACSB accredited, and first offered a business administration degree in 1940. Today, the College of Business grants almost 20 percent of WSU's undergraduate degrees, making business one of the most popular majors on campus. Finance majors participating in the Cougar Investment Fund class have the opportunity to manage over two million dollars of the University's endowment. The Department of Finance and Management Science has a research-oriented faculty and offers one of the largest undergraduate business programs within the College of Business. The communities of Pullman, Washington and Moscow, Idaho, each contain a major state university and are located eight miles apart in the scenic Palouse Hills area of eastern Washington and northern Idaho.

Application materials should include a letter addressing each of the qualification criteria, a current CV, recent teaching evaluations, and the names and contact information of three references. Review of applications will begin May 8, 2017, and will continue until the position is filled. Two faculty members from the department will be at the POMS conference in Seattle during May 5-8, 2017.
