We seek individuals with research and teaching interests at the interface of Operations Research and Information Systems. In particular, individuals in the areas of Business and Data Analytics, Statistical Analysis, Data Mining, and Data-Driven Decision Making are encouraged to apply. Interest in practical problems and applications is highly desirable. A record of excellence in research and teaching, or a demonstration of clear promise is required. Appointment is expected at the Assistant level, however applicants for a more senior appointment will be considered. This position is subject to budgetary approval.

The successful candidate will be expected to conduct active and innovative research programs and to teach at the undergraduate and postgraduate level. UOIT is a technology-enhanced learning environment and seeks faculty members who strive to explore and develop new pedagogies by integrating technology in the curriculum.
