The candidate is also expected to actively participate in major academic conferences in supply chain management and operations management, and in professional activities that promote and enhance the reputation of NC State University and the Poole College of Management.

The successful candidate will also be committed to excellent teaching in undergraduate and graduate programs and will be prepared to work with our Supply Chain Resource Cooperative, a cooperative within the Business Management Department that provides our interface with the business community.
