A proven track record of active research showing the ability or potential to publish high-quality research in premier business journals. Proficiency in emerging methodologies, specifically including AI, applicable to business and management. An excellent teaching record (if applicable), at undergraduate and/or graduate levels, analytics-related courses (e.g., information systems, operations management, database, business statistics, data mining, machine learning, etc.).

An outstanding track record and/or strong potential to publish in prestigious FT-50 OM/IS journals (e.g., Management Science, MIS Quarterly, Information Systems Research, Manufacturing and Service Operations Management, Production and Operations Management, etc.), and/or in leading journals across different disciplines (e.g., finance, accounting, marketing, etc.). Advanced expertise in AI, machine learning, large language models, and their innovative applications in business and management. Experience teaching in different formats (e.g., in-person, online, and hybrid), at the undergraduate and/or MBA/MS levels. Demonstrated ability and/or potential to secure funding for research and/or educational programs
