Ph.D. student applicants in an Allbut-Dissertation (ABD) status will be considered, if and only if they will receive a qualified Ph.D. degree before the time of appointment.
- Capability of teaching courses in the fields described in the Job Description.
- Ability to publish research articles in high-quality academic journals.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Accepted /published articles or with a well-established research pipeline.
- Prior publications in high-quality research journals or other evidence of research potential.
- Previous teaching experience in business analytics, operations management, and supply chain management at the college level.
- Proficiency in Excel, R, data mining tools, mathematical programming software, data analytics, and related areas.
