

## Assistant Professor in Supply Chain Management Rutgers Business School, Newark and New Brunswick

The Department of Supply Chain Management at Rutgers Business School - Newark and New Brunswick invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position in Supply Chain Management starting September 1, 2025. Successful applicants should hold a Ph.D. in the areas of Management Science, Operations Research, Computer Science, Data Science, or related fields, with a specific focus on the application of Data Analytics and Applied AI in Supply Chain Management (SCM) and established research pipelines.

### Key Responsibilities:

- Conduct research in supply chain management and data science.
- Teach courses in supply chain management and data science areas at both undergraduate and graduate levels.
- Engage in professional service activities as determined by the Department and School.
- Maintain a strong record of productivity and quality in published research, teaching, and service activities.

### Qualifications:

- Ph.D. in Management Science, Operations Research, Computer Science, Data Science/AI, or related fields, with several years of experience in academic and/or corporate research.
- Strong research record with an emphasis on supply chain management and data science.
- Established record of publications in *Financial Times* – 50 journals or top IEEE engineering journals.
- Demonstrated teaching effectiveness with a proven ability to engage students.
- Ability to contribute to the department's future growth and provide research project leadership in Data Science/Applied AI.

Department of Supply Chain Management: The SCM department includes 17 tenured and tenure-track faculty and 14 professional practice faculty specializing in supply chain analytics, sustainability, supply chain finance, logistics and healthcare operations. The department's faculty regularly publish in and serve on editorial boards of FT-50 journals, including *Management Science*, *Operations Research*, *Manufacturing and Service Operations Management*, *Production and Operations Management*, and *Journal of Operations Management*. The department offers degrees in Supply Chain Management at all levels, from undergraduate through PhD and DBA, serving over 1400 students. In 2024, the SCM graduate and undergraduate programs were ranked No. 3 and No. 5 by Gartner, respectively. The SCM online graduate program was ranked No. 2 by *U.S. News & World Report*. The newly established Healthcare Analytics and Intelligence graduate program was ranked No.2 by Analytics Degrees. The SCM Department has deep industry engagement through its highly-regarded Rutgers Center for Supply Chain Management, which partners with many global corporations, and through its faculty of professional practice, from upper levels of management in major organizations. Since 2021, the department has hosted the annual Supply Chain Analytics Institute Conference, which has attracted hundreds of academic researchers and industry experts to share the latest advancements in analytics and data science within the supply chain field.
